

## Fact Sheet:

IPOD Touch - \$299 from the Apple Store. Can be purchased online.

iTunes 7.2 (free from Apple)

Videora – Freeware; donations accepted. (Converts downloaded video to iPhone/iPod touch format) Can also accept dvd input.

AthletiShare download: \$9.95 per video.

A small price to pay to be able to take video with you on the road.

How much video. 10 full game videos on the cheapest IPOD touch or IPHONE. Double that for another \$100. About 60 minutes of video takes up about 700megs of space.

That is two full high school games.

From 6 minutes to 30 minutes to download a full game from AthletiShare.

About 1.5 hours to convert the wmv video to MPEG-4 codec using a freeware package.

About 2 minutes to move the MPEG-4 encoded game from the computer to the iPod.

## How to use the iPod from your PC:

1. You will need an IPOD Touch or iPhone.
2. Download iTunes.
3. Download an IPOD Touch file converter program. Check out [www.videora.com](http://www.videora.com).
4. Download a game from AthletiShare. You can download one of your own games or you can download games you have through game exchange or if you represent a college, create a subscriber account to download games at \$9.95 each. No charge to create an account.
5. Drag the game from your PC to the Videora application or similar application.
6. The app will convert your video to a new codec (MPEG-4 H.254). This will take about three times as long as it would take to play the video with Windows Media Player.
7. Sync your IPOD to your PC. Make sure you have checked “Manually Manage Music and Videos”
